Commentary

The questions covered a variety of courses in the PADI system. They were varied and the multiple-choice selection was typical of a multiple-choice exam, 2 that were obviously wrong and then down to two to select from.

A number of the questions used "purpose", so there was not a variety, they became very repetitive, and 1 of 30 questions had the same answers with a question asked slightly differently. The questions were very basic and lacked some scenario-based requirements that we now see in revised professional exams. So although ChatGPT provided a variety of questions on a variety of PADI courses, I am not sure that the questions are complex enough to challenge professional candidates. Second the questions primarily start with WHAT.

Interesting to note, I wanted to retry my search with some additional parameters. I wanted to start with the same prompt had had previously used and then additionally add in requests for scenarios however, there has been a change in copywrite information and received the following warning:
